## Important notice to candidates appearing for IV examination in Maharashtra and not having any proof to be a residence of Maharashtra

With reference to recent letter issued by MMB of dated 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2016.

1. Candidates appearing for Inland Vessel Examination (IV Exam) in Maharashtra State and not having **any proof to be a resident of Maharashtra** and are staying on board **Inland Vessel**, will be permitted to appear for the same, subject to fulfilling the following condition:-

- (a) Submit an undertaking that, accommodation space has been provided by Master/Owner of the vessel and have no other accommodation in Maharashtra State.
- (b) This undertaking has to be countersigned by owner of the Vessel/Company.

2. Further, MMB has also decided that **Police Verification** will be required for issuance of Certificate of Competency (CoC's) for candidates not having passport as address proof.

3. Candidates who have not submitted the copy of their <u>PASSPORT</u> as address proof and appearing for IV Examination are required to produce/submit the <u>POLICE VERIFICATION</u> report within 10 days after the result is announced, without which BES will not issue the CoC's.
