The last year of service out of the 4 years must have been on a harbor motor vessel as <u>helms-man / deckhand</u>	At least 3 (three) years of service as <u>Serang-in-charge</u> of a motor launch of over 80 BHP holding <u>COC as Serang</u> OR At least 5 (five) years of service on motor vessel operating at sea or on inland waters, of which last 3 (three) years of service as <u>helms-man / deck hand</u> having not less than 226 BHP	At least 3 (three) years of service as 2nd Class Master-in-Charge of an inland motor vessel while possessing a second class master's COC OR At least 4 (four) years of service as Serang or 2nd serang of a motor vessel while possessing a second class master's COC
