NOTICE TO FAILED CANDIDATES

1. **Board of Examinations for Seafarers Trust (BES), Navi Mumbai** functioning under the authority of the DG Shipping, GOI is entrusted by Maharashtra Maritime Board, Mumbai to carry out the examinations for their marine crew as per the I.V Act' 1917.
2. BES invites filled in **Failed Candidate's Application Form** from the candidates **who have failed in the June 2019 and subsequent examinations** for the IV examinations of Grades - Master Class 1, Master Class 2, Master Class 3 (Syrang), IV Engineer, 1st Class Engine Driver and 2nd Class Engine Driver.
3. The candidate who has failed in the written examinations held in June 2019 and afterwards will appear for the **WRITTEN EXAMINATION** first if, is successful, then will appear the **ORAL** examinations.
4. The candidate who has passed in written examination held either in June 2019 or afterwards, but failed in the oral, s/he will appear **only the ORAL**
5. BES will conduct the examinations consisting of **Written and Oral** in Marathi, Hindi and English languages in **March 2022**. The failed candidate may choose to appear in any one of these three languages.
6. The failed candidate who desires to repeat the examination is to download the following forms from BES web site www.seafarers.edu.in
 - a) *Failed Candidate's Application Form*
 - b) *Failed Candidate's Checklist*
7. The candidate shall fill in the Failed Candidate's Application Form and attach all necessary testimonials in orderly manner as detailed Application form and the Checklist.
8. The candidates may use BES Checklist and FAQs as a guide, to complete the failed candidate's Application Form.
9. The failed candidate shall attach copy of **VALID MEDICAL** certificate to the Form.
10. The fees for the examinations are to be paid by the failed candidates in two parts. First Part – Examination Fee and Second Part - Certification Fee. **THERE IS NO ASSESSMENT FEE.**


11. The cut-off date for the receipt of completed Application Form at BES office is **27th December 2021.** Any form received after this date will not be entertained.
12. The candidate will send his/her filled-in **“Failed Candidate’s Application Form”** to BES along with all required document through Speed post / Courier service , writing it as follows:

13. The list of candidates who have applied for the examinations will be uploaded in our website www.seafarers.edu.in and called for verification of document, if in order, then BES will collect DD and issue Admit Card.
14. Any incomplete **“Failed Candidate’s Application Form”** will not be processed.
15. Any Failed Candidate’s Application Form received with false information or found at a later date with false information will be rejected, Certificate of Competency (CoC) if issued, will be withdrawn and the candidate will be liable for punishment as per the law.
